Entries received after the postmark of May 13th will be charged an extra fee of \$5.00 per class (with the exception of youth classes) in addition to regular class fees.

All participating horses must be ASPC or AMHR registered. All horses must be measured or present a valid measurement card. Stalls are \$65.00 (two horse maximum). Camper hook-ups are \$30.00/night. Valid ASPC or AMHR registration, coggins dated within 12 months for out-of-state horses, health certificate within 30 days for out-of-state horses, youth and/or amateur numbers must be provided. **Make checks payable to: Mid America Miniature Horse Club (MAMHC). General Rules and Information:

This show is accredited and conducted under the 2017 rules and regulations of the American Miniature Horse Registry and American Shetland Pony Club.

All horses must be registered with the American Miniature Horse Registry or American Shetland Pony Club.

This show is triple judged. Points and awards will be awarded by each judge. "Show bucks" will be awarded for 1st – 6th places. They may be traded in for ribbons at the show office if you wish.

Championship Ribbons will be awarded to Junior/Senior Champions & Reserves and Grand Champions & Reserves. Champion of Champions will receive Neck Sashes.

Welcome to The Champions Center!

Stabling: Shavings available for \$7.50 per bag. No more than two horses per stall. If you wish to be stabled with another exhibitor/farm, please indicate this on your entry form. Early arrival/layover fees are \$15.00 per stall. No outside shavings allowed.

Early Arrival/Layovers: If you plan on arriving before Thursday or stay after Sunday, please notify Laura Mullen at 607-769-6743 or Winectry@aol.com. The Early Arrival/Layover Fee is \$15.00 per additional night per stall.

Wash Rack: Paved wash rack areas at designated locations in the barn.

Arena: Indoor Arena with Make Up Area

Show Hours: The show will run from 8:00 a.m. until finished.

Camping: Camper hookups available. Camper permits are \$30.00/night. Bathrooms with showers are available for both men and women.

Food Stand: Food and refreshments will be available during the show.

Smoking: No smoking will be allowed in the barns, the arena or in the horse show office. No alcohol is allowed on the show grounds.

General Rules and Information

Entry Fees: **Open & Stake Classes: \$45.00; Amateur Classes: \$40.00; Youth Classes and COOL Classes: \$30.00. Flat Fee Package: \$150 per horse (Pre-entry)/\$175.00 per horse (Post-Entry)**

Youth Classes: All youth must have an ASPC/AMHR Youth number if you wish to have your points count for All Stars & Hall of Fame. Application for a Youth card may be filled out day of show at the Horse Show Office. Youth membership is free, but must be applied for each year. **ASPC/AMHR youth are those youth who have not reached 18 years of age by December 1st of the current competition year.**

Amateur Classes: An ASPC/AMHR Amateur Card is required to participate in Amateur classes. Amateur cards are \$15.00 to at the show and you must be an ASPC/AMHR member to apply. Applications are available at the Horse Show Office and from the Show Steward.

Stalls: \$65.00 (two horses per stall maximum). Shavings available for purchase for \$7.50 per bag. No straw allowed for bedding. Stall cleanings to be dumped in designated areas only.

Measuring: Measuring will take place on Thursday from 4:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m., each morning from 7:00-8:00 a.m. and upon request throughout the remainder of the show weekend by contacting the show office. All horses must be measured. Exhibitor packets and numbers will be issued after measurement. A clear copy of your registration papers must be presented at measuring.

Office Information: Please have a copy of your horse's coggins current within 12 months and a 30-day health certificate on all out-of-state horses. Judges Evaluation Forms will be available in the Show Office, and may be completed on a voluntary basis. If a horse is gelded, "gelding" must be indicated on the registration papers in order to show.

Entries: All entry forms, copies of both sides of the ASPC/AMHR registration papers for each horse, copy of Coggins papers, copy of Amateur and/or Youth cards, and a check/money order in payment of classes, stalls, RV fees, etc., are to be sent to Show Manager Laura Mullen. Checks are to be made payable to **Mid America Miniature Horse Club (MAMHC)**. Entries postmarked after the pre-entry deadline will be assessed a post-entry fee of \$5.00 per class (exception - youth classes). This fee will be strictly enforced. Any checks not honored by the bank will be charged a \$35.00 NSF fee. All monies must be paid or an open check left at the office before numbers will be issued.

Refunds: Refunds will only be given on receipt of a veterinary certificate stating the reason the horse may not be shown. Stall fees and office fees will not be refunded.

PA System: It is the owner/handler/exhibitor's responsibility to be on time for classes. Announcements to the barn area are a management courtesy. We will be using a two-minute gate call. Please check in with the gate person when you arrive at the gate.

Special Needs: Exhibitors with special needs are welcome to participate in the show. If special accommodations are needed, please let the show manager know in advance.

Pets: All dogs must be leashed.

Conduct: Cruelty, abuse or inhumane treatment of any horse in the show ring, barn, stalls or on the fairgrounds is strictly prohibited. The use of stimulants or depressants or any drug affecting the showing of a horse is forbidden. Anyone guilty of the above will have their entries cancelled and will be ordered off the grounds immediately. No refunds will be given.
